

Drainage and Sewer Control Committee
October 3, 2007, 7:00PM, Macedonia City Center
Regular Meeting

- I. The meeting was called to order at 7:09PM.
- II. **Attendees are as follows:**

- III. Minutes from the 9/5/2007 meeting were approved by unanimous vote.
- IV. **Mike McNutt, Tinkers Creek Watershed Partners:** Mike and Harry provided the committee with a folder of information about Tinkers Creek Watershed Partners, and gave a presentation as well. The yearly membership fee is \$500 for a community, and they can provide us with public outreach and education information. After the presentation, members of the committee unanimously agreed to recommend council vote to join TCWP.
- V. **Old Business**
- A. **Where does Phase II stand?** Currently council has only voted to go ahead with the storm system mapping, at a cost of \$30K. Steve would like to front end load the projects and then use a storm water utility to pay down the debt. Amanda agreed to send a copy of the Phase II Estimates spreadsheet to Steve via email.
- B. **Contacting residents who requested follow-ups:** Those who contacted residents will forward an email to others on the committee. Tom will look into a file sharing service or ftp so members can update the spreadsheet when people are contacted.
- C. **Crow/Hampton Dam Follow-up:** Per Jim the project was completed at a cost of \$7800. Steve and Laurie Booth sent an email thanking everyone for the progress on this project.
- D. **Creating survey spreadsheets for DSCC use:** Cathy has about 300 done, and is still working on it.
- E. **Letter about encroachment blocking Crow swale:** Jim advised the committee that he was just contacted by the homeowner. They had done work and dumped the dirt in said location. Jim recommended that she hire a contractor to remove the dirt, and she agreed to do so.
- F. **Flooding situation at 8566 N. Bedford:** Perhaps there is some federal funding available to modify the garage of this home? The service department put a new catch basin in at 8524 N. Bedford, but this will not

affect the flooding for 8566, it is hoped that it will help lessen the flooding of the roadway itself.

VII. Q & A for Residents: Per the Gabriels, the service department replaced a pipe at Ledge and Skyland. Cleveland Water did a repair there and broke the storm water pipe, so the service department replaced it. Jim says that the water flowing onto the Gabriel's property will not increase, as the water was still running over the street prior to fixing the pipe. The Gabriels also requested for either the service department or the parks department to repair the stone dam and clean up the garbage in Sugarbush Park. They are unable to continue cleaning the pond on their property, and it continues to fill with silt coming from the park. Jim agreed to look at the rock dam. Jan said she would speak with Chief Golden about the trash in the park. Dennis also asked if a silt fence would help to keep the silt from filling the Gabriel's pond.
