MAYOR'S REPORT:

~Mayor met with officials from the city of Twinsburg and the villages of Oakwood and Glenwillow regarding the intersection at Shepard and Broadway Road, shared by all four communities. Mayor Migliorini said Macedonia will be participating in the re-renovation of the intersection unlike during the first renovation and realignment in which only Glenwillow, Oakwood and Twinsburg participated. The new renovation/improvement consists of adding turning lanes to lessen the traffic congestion. Though participating legislation will be forthcoming, the project is not expected to let until 2019 as the community's are applying for funding from a variety of sources including Issue 2 and CDBG.

Recreation Department Director Manley reminded residents of Spirit of Macedonia Fun Fest this year during the week-end of June 8-11. The schedule of events and programming includes but is limited to a classic car show, a 5K Run, amusement rides, food vendors and live music all of which and more is posted on Recreation Center's Facebook and website.

Finance Department Director Hall reported May revenue was \$1,050,344.92 up by \$293,828.29 from last year's revenue of \$846,516.63. JEDD revenue to date of \$99,687.96 is up by \$306.75. Ms. Hall added about half the invoices from WM&E mailing have been processed.

Fire Department Chief Black reported that this year the fire department will not only be cleaning and flushing hydrants in Macedonia but Northfield Center and Sagamore Hills as well.

Police Department Lt Yakopovich on behalf of Chief Golden reported that K-9 Officer Haro successfully located a \$3,000 earring aide of a child lost in playground mulch in Jackson Township. When school officials were unsuccessful finding the earring aide, Officer Hathaway, whose children attend the same school was called because of his partner Officer Haro. The story posted of police department Facebook has been viewed 700,000 times Lt. Yakopovich added.
