ORDINANCE NO. 47 – 2015

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE REPLACING THE EXISTING MACEDONIA  
OCCUPANCY PROGRAM AS ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NUMBER 108 – 2007, AND  
AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NUMBER 81 – 2009, AND REPLACING IT WITH NEW  
CHAPTER 191, TO BE KNOWN AS THE "MACEDONIA OCCUPANCY AND  
JOBS CREATION PROGRAM"

WHEREAS, economic development within the City of Macedonia is a major priority in order to continue and enhance the income tax base, and to provide services to our residents; and

WHEREAS, tax incentives to new businesses coming into the City of Macedonia have been provided in the past, and in order to provide additional tools to the Administration in keeping existing businesses in the community, it is the desire of Council to provide a similar program and tax incentive to existing businesses who are expanding their presence, and increasing the number of employees who pay income tax to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED the Council of the City of Macedonia, Summit County, State of Ohio:

Section 1. There is hereby and herein created a new Chapter 191 of the Codified Ordinances, entitled "Macedonia Occupancy and Jobs Creation program", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as exhibit "A".

Section 2. Upon adoption of this ordinance and the new chapter 191, previous ordinances 108-2007 and 81- 2009 are hereby and herein repealed in their entirety.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. Wherefore, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Macedonia and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it provides for the daily operation of a municipal department, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of three (3) or more of the members elected or appointed to this Council, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
