APPLICATION FOR REFUND OF .25% (1/4 of 1.0%) PORTION
OF CITY INCOME TAX PER CITY CODE SECTION 182.03 FOR 2018

To be eligible, you must be a Macedonia resident and have filed your 2018 city income tax return with RITA (Regional Income Tax Agency). In addition, you must have paid 2.25% in city income tax to Macedonia or less to a municipality other than Macedonia causing a balance due payment to meet the 2.25% requirement for 2018. Any income earned and related city income tax paid in municipalities with a city income tax rate of 2.25% or more is not eligible for a refund.

Filing deadline for this application is July 15, 2019 for the 2018 tax year. You must file your city income tax return with RITA by April 15th (or approved extended date) before you can file this application. The July 15th deadline will be extended for the same period a RITA extension is granted.

REFUND CALCULATION

1. Total Taxable Income per line 2 from 2018 RITA return	
2. Macedonia 2018 tax rate	X 2.25%
3. Macedonia tax paid (line 1 times line 2)	
4. Multiply line 1 by 2.0% (non-refundable portion)	
5. Subtract line 4 from 3 for amount of refund requested

Applicant must be in good standing with RITA with no delinquencies. Any discrepancies between the amount of refund being requested and the data on your RITA tax form used to confirm the amount of refund will cause a delay

This application, along with a copy of your RITA tax return must be received by the City Finance Department. The refund is subject to Federal (IRS), state and local laws and RITA regulations.
