## **ORDINANCE NO. 42 - 2020**

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$575,000 OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES OF THE CITY OF MACEDONIA, OHIO IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO PAY THE PROPERTY OWNERS' PORTION OF THE COSTS, IN ANTICIPATION OF THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS, RELATED TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF A RIGHT-IN RIGHT-OUT ACCESS ROAD OFF OF STATE ROUTE 8 TO PROVIDE INGRESS AND EGRESS TO THE CROSSINGS AT GOLDEN LINK SHOPPING CENTER, TOGETHER WITH ALL NECESSARY APPURTENANCES AND RELATED IMPROVEMENTS THERETO was **offered by Mrs. Tulley** and moved Council waive the requirement that it be read by title on three different days, instructing the Clerk to read it by title only for all three readings. **Second by Mr. Ventura** carried unanimously on a voice vote.

Mrs. Tulley moved, Mr. Ventura seconded, and motion carried unanimously on voice vote to adopt **ORD. NO. 42-2020** and post according to law. **ORD. NO. 42-2020 declared and adopted** 

Relative to ORD NO. 42-2020: Director Veres states that the bond anticipation of \$575,000 is just an estimate, that the city must make sure that out ceiling is high enough in the case that we did need to borrow that much. 98% of this will be done through property owners' costs over a 20-year period. There will be legislation next year as well for the 20- year cycle. The City's cost to this is 2%. Mayor Molar stated how this has been a project that has been needed for a long time, it will put in place many safety features. He knows that the property owners will be paying for the majority, but it is much appreciated and much needed.
